

For this assignment, there is nothing to “turn-in” to the digital dropbox on Blackboard. Instead, you will create a table in your Oracle table space and grant the instructor privileges to read and modify the table. When you have created the table, set the privileges, and are ready to “turn-in” your assignment, send the instructor an email message at rcapra3@unc.edu with a subject line of “hw9 is ready” and in the body of the email include: 1) your Onyen, and 2) your SILS Oracle username (e.g. db2\_19).

**Note: It is very important that in the body of your email, you include: 1) your Onyen, and 2) your SILS Oracle username (e.g. db2\_19). If you don't include these, your assignment may not be graded.**

### **The Assignment**

Create a table named **hw9** with the following fields:

id	number
quotation	varchar(200)
attribution	varchar(80)

id is the primary key field.

Insert 2 or 3 of your favorite quotations into the table and indicate to whom they are attributed in the attribution field.

Grant the user db2\_19 (this is my testing account) the permission(s) necessary for db2\_19 to access the table and successfully issue the following SQL commands (where db2\_N is your username).

- 1) `SELECT * from db2_N.hw9;`
- 2) `INSERT into db2_N.hw9 values (4, 'to be or not to be', 'hamlet');`
